


CITY OF LABELLE, FLORIDA  
NOTICE OF INTENT TO USE UNIFORM METHOD OF COLLECTING  
NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENTS

The City of LaBelle, Florida (the “City”) hereby provides notice, pursuant to Section 197.3632(3)(a), Florida Statutes, of its intent to use the uniform method of collecting non-ad valorem special assessments to fund the maintenance, repairs, and abatement of nuisance, abandoned or unsafe structures and properties, to be levied throughout the incorporated area of the City, commencing with the Fiscal Year beginning on October 1, 2022 and continuing until discontinued by the City. The City will consider the adoption of a resolution electing to use the uniform method of collecting such assessments authorized by Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, at a public hearing to be held at 481 West Hickpochee Avenue, LaBelle, Florida 33935 on March 10, 2022 at 6 p.m. Such resolution will state the need for the levy and will contain a legal description of the boundaries of the real property subject to the levy. Copies of the proposed form of resolution, which contain the legal description of the real property subject to the levy, are on file at the City Clerk’s Office in City Hall, located at 481 West Hickpochee Avenue, LaBelle, Florida. All interested persons are invited to attend the public hearing. In the event any person decides to appeal any decision by the City Commission with respect to any matter relating to the consideration of the resolution at the above-referenced public hearing, a record of the proceeding may be needed and in such an event, such person may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the public hearing is made, which record includes the testimony and evidence on which the appeal is to be based. In accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act and Section 286.26, Florida Statutes, the location of this public hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities. If you are a person with a disability who needs any accommodation in order to participate in this proceeding, you are entitled, at no cost to you, to the provision of certain assistance.
