INVITATION TO BID

Sealed BIDS will be received by the City of LaBelle for the **LaBelle Zone A Part 2 Septic Tank Conversion** project for the construction of a gravity sewer system and installation of watermains. This is a continuation of the LaBelle Zone A Part 1 Septic Tank Conversion project, which was completed at the end of 2021. The project consists of a base bid and a total of seven alternates for the total construction of approximately 8,845 linear feet of 8" PVC SDR-26 gravity main, up to thirty-seven (37) manholes, up to ninety-eight (98) new gravity sewer service laterals from the gravity main to the ROW, up to seventy-seven (77) new gravity sewer service laterals from the ROW to the house connection point and abandonment of the septic tanks. Additional work to be performed at an existing lift station site at the intersection of Washington Avenue and North Missouri Street which potentially involves the installation of a generator. Water utilities are to be installed with the construction of approximately 11,077 linear feet of 6" PVC (DR-18) water main with fittings, approximately 516 linear feet of 8" HDPE with fittings, approximately thirty-one (31) 6" gate valves, forty (40) 3-way fire hydrants, up to fifty-seven (57) new water service lateral connections to existing meters, and up to twenty-nine (29) new water service lateral stubouts. Connections to the existing water main will be made at the intersection of Fort Thompson Avenue & North Lee Street, Washington Avenue & Missouri Street, Oklahoma Avenue & Missouri Street, and Yeomans Avenue & Lee Street, Riverview Street & State Road 80, Oak Street & State Road 80, Hickory Street & State Road 80, and Elm Street & State Road 80. Abandonment of the existing water main will occur in the project area. New road installation occurring on Washington Avenue, Oklahoma Avenue, and Hickory Street as well as a gravel road installation on Hickory Street. The project includes all paving, roadway construction, grading, sodding, restoration, and site work; and all incidental work needed to provide an in-place, functioning system.

Bids will be received by the City of LaBelle, Florida, at LaBelle City Hall, 481 W. Hickpochee Ave., LaBelle, Florida 33935, until 2:00 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022. An original and two copies must be provided. Bids will be opened on May 12<sup>th</sup>, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. local time in the LaBelle City Hall Commission Chambers. Late submissions will not be accepted and will be returned unopened.
