NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING  
FFY 2020/2021 PROPOSED CDBG HOUSING REHABILITATION APPLICATION**

The City of LaBelle plans to apply to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for a FFY 2020 and/or FFY 2021 as needed to receive funding, Housing Category Small Cities Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) of \$700,000. The activities, dollar amounts and estimated percentage benefit to low-and moderate- income persons are as follows:

A public hearing to provide citizens an opportunity to comment on the application will be held in the City Commission Chambers located at the LaBelle City Hall, 481 W. Hickpochee Avenue, LaBelle, Florida, on Thursday, July 14, 2022, at 6:00 p.m., or as soon as possible thereafter. A draft copy of the application will be available for review by July 7, 2022, Noon EDT at City Hall. A final copy of the application will be made available at the LaBelle City Hall located at 481 Hickpochee Avenue, LaBelle, FL on Monday through Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. within five days after submission of the application. The application is expected to be submitted to FDEO on or about July 21, 2022.
